

LEADERSHIP LEAD POSITION DESCRIPTION

Leadership Lead Mission:

As an integral part of EO's member leader community, Leadership Leads serve as subject matter experts (SME) for EO's Leadership Products which include Leadership Academies and the Path of Leadership. Leadership Lead can also be responsible for the implementation of initiatives outlined in their region's action plan that relate to leadership development. The Leadership Leads are selected and directed by their respective regional council. The Leadership Lead can consult with the Leadership Director to attain product knowledge and for general advisory.

Qualifications:

- Has served as a chair at the chapter level and attended GLC
- Has an unwavering passion to impact their chapter, region, EO and themselves through EO Leadership Products
- Is a subject matter expert in Leadership
- Is aligned with EO's purpose, ambition and values
- Preference given to a Leadership Academy graduate

Expectations and Responsibilities:

- Promote Leadership Academies
 - a. Regional Leadership Academy, and Global Leadership Academy
- Path of Leadership (POL)
 - a. Promote POL and build pipeline of future regional leaders
- Participate regularly on regional calls to share about leadership products
- With the Regional Chair's approval, the Leadership Lead could serve on one or both of these organizing committees:
 - a. The regional RLA organizing committee
 - b. The regional leadership summit
 - c. Other regional leadership events
- Support chapter chairs according to their respective needs by:
 - a. Participating in regularly scheduled calls with chapter officer(s)
 - b. Identifying and implementing solutions for leadership challenges and roadblocks

Term and time commitment:

- The term for the Leadership Lead is one fiscal year with the opportunity to reapply for a second year
- Participate on regularly scheduled regional calls
- Connect with the Functional Leadership Team quarterly for updates on products and programmes
- Communication with local chairs as needed or requested by regional council
- Chapter, global or regional event attendance as required
